<b>Conditions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A maximum of two (2) monumental plaques are permitted on any one plot, subject to approval.</li> <li>2. The specific location of headstones and monumental plaques with the burial plot is at the final discretion of Council.</li> <li>3. The monument must not encroach on adjoining burial plots.</li> <li>4. The monument must be consistent with the existing amenity of the local government cemetery.</li> <li>5. The monument must be constructed of suitable weather resistance material and noting the poor water quality used for watering at the Lawn Cemetery.</li> <li>6. Maintenance or repair work on a memorial to a deceased person must only be carried out by a member of the family of the deceased person, or another person who has a proper interest in the maintenance of the memorial to the deceased person.</li> </ol>
