Coppermine Creek Bridge Replacement Road Closure September 2024 – June 2025

Cloncurry Shire Council wishes to advise that work on the Coppermine Creek Bridge Replacement project will commence the week beginning Monday, 2 September 2024.

Works will include the demolition of the current bridge and the construction of a new bridge, which will be a new dual-line bridge with a shared pathway and new lighting.

While works are in process, the following changes to road conditions will be implemented.

DATE	ROAD/ASSETS IMPACTED	IMPACTS

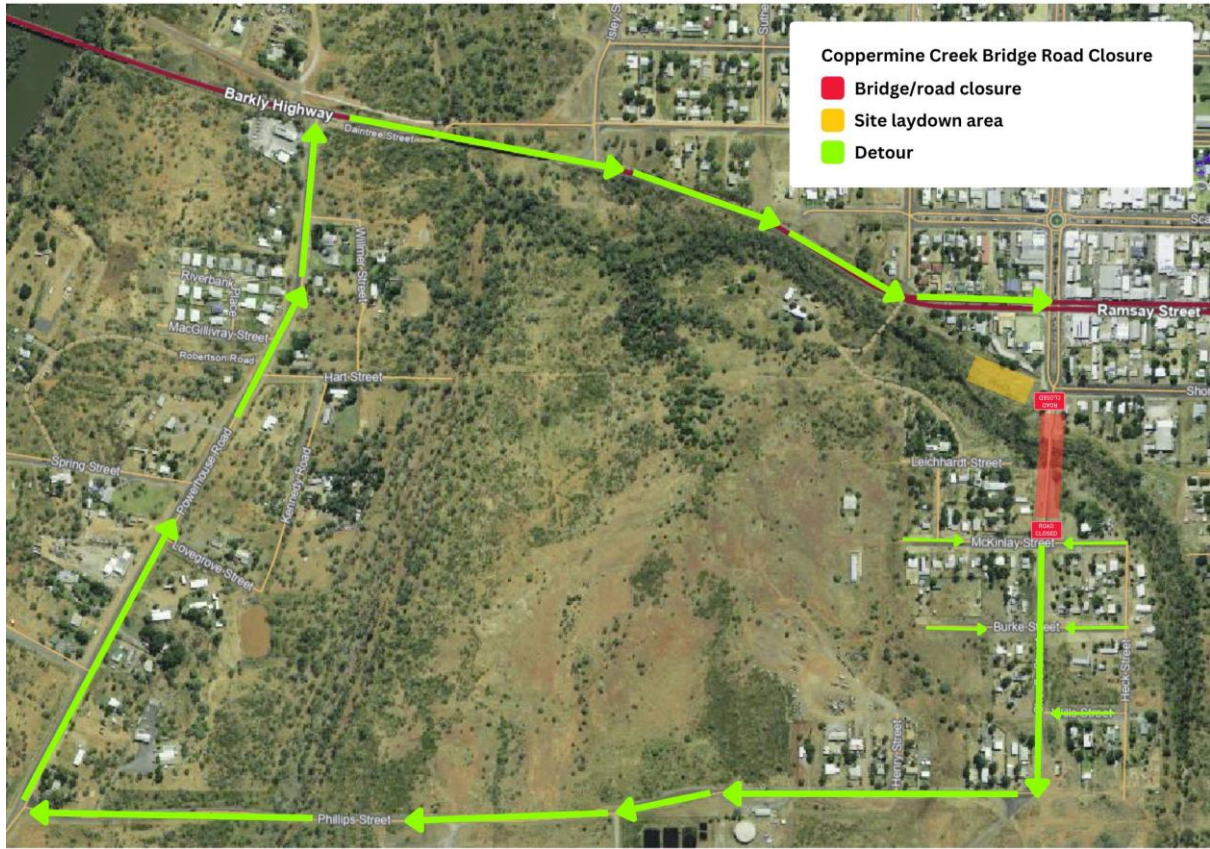


Figure 1: Coppermine Creek Bridge road closure September 2024 – June 2025

2 September 2024 – 30 June 2025	Coppermine Creek Bridge (Sheaffe Street)	Coppermine Creek Bridge closed to all traffic. <u>Vehicles</u> Access to the southern side of the bridge will be accessible via Powerhouse Road and Phillips Street. <u>Pedestrians</u> Pedestrians will still be able to cross the creek, initially via the current bridge and later by a temporary access bridge. Follow all construction and traffic management signage. Refer to Figure 1.

Work hours will be 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 7:00am to 4:00pm on Saturday. Work will not take place on Sunday or public holidays.

Council appreciates your patience and understanding during this project and thanks you for your cooperation during the construction phase. Council will continue to provide updates throughout this project.
